#### I: GENERAL

- All of our outdoor experiences and events are weather dependant. We will make every effort to fulfill your booking but if we feel the weather isnt suitable or poses a danger to staff or the public we will have to cancel the activity. If possible we will aim to reschedule.
- If ever we feel our staff are in danger they will be removed from the situation
- Children under the age of 16 should always be accompanied by an adult
- Wear clothing that covers your arms and legs and try to avoid Loose fitting tops.
- Scarves, large earrings and facial jewellery must be removed.
- Long hair should be tied back.
- Wear suitable footwear Flat soles with covered toes such as boots or trainers would be most appropriate. Sandals and high heels are definitely not suitable.
- We operate a strict no alcohol, no drugs policy. If you're not safe you don't shoot.
- No one should ever be in front of the archery line when shooting is taking place.
- If multiple archers are shooting they must be alongside each other straddling the shooting line.
- Never point an arrow at another person and certainly never aim a drawn bow at someone.
- Never shoot an arrow straight up in the air.
- If *anyone* shouts the word "FAST" it is not safe to "Loose" the arrow. You must lower the bow and remove the arrow from the string.
- Never "Dry Loose" a bow. That means to release the sting without an arrow on the bow. Without an arrow on the string the stored energy can snap the bow.
- Never approach the target to collect arrows unless given the command to do so, other archers may still be shooting.
- Don't Run to collect.
- When going to collect arrows beware of arrows in the grass.
- Never walk straight towards your target, If you do trip you could fall face first into the arrows.
- Stand to the side of the target when pulling arrows out of the boss.
- Check that nobody is standing directly behind you before removing an arrow.



## II: EVENTS

- An archery range requires a minimum of 15m x 25m x 20m x 25m
- Ideally there will be a wall or earth mound behind the range
- There should never be public access behind the range. If there is we will require 100m behind the range.
- If the Rain is too Heavy or the wind is too strong we may have to stop the activity for safety.
- Deposits of 50% must be paid upon booking to secure the reservation with the remainder paid no later than the day of the event
- if an event is cancelled by the organiser with less than 14 days notice then payment must be made in full

# III: Schools

Children will be instructed by our instructors but remain under the control of the teachers.
 Ideally there should be one teacher or teaching assistant for every 10 children and never less than two.

### IV: Experiences and Courses

- All events are weather permitting. We will strive to deliver in any weather but in the event of very bad weather we may have to reschedule.
- Please dress appropriately, Venues can be muddy and weather is invariably changeable.
- Spectators are welcome if booked ahead of the event. Let us know at time of booking any spectators who will be attending
- If you need to reschedule please try to give as much notice as possible.



# v: Equipment rental

#### Restrictions

- Equipment rented should be used in the intended manner for that particular piece of equipment unless agreement is made in advance that the usage is safe.
- Bows should be unstrung between use as bows left strung can be damaged beyond repair.
- o Arrows and bolts may be altered so long as it is agreed in advance
- Any items damaged or broken will be charged for in full

#### Logistics

Red Fox historical Archery will arrange delivery and collection of all items

#### Maintenance

- If any items require maintenance Red Fox historical Archery can make provision for the items to be repaired or maintained. (depending on the item and the amount of work required this may incur a fee)
- alternatively I can provide instruction on how to repair or maintain most items

## Payment

- Length of lease is negotiable and is usually charged on a weekly basis
- longer leases can be agreed in advance
- 50% Deposit is payable in advance
- Outstanding payment will be due upon completion of the lease period

#### Insurance

• All items are covered by product liability

### · Damaged items

- Missing damaged or broken items will be charged at full retail price on top of the rental price.
- Items modified without prior agreement will be charged at full retail price on top of the rental fee.
